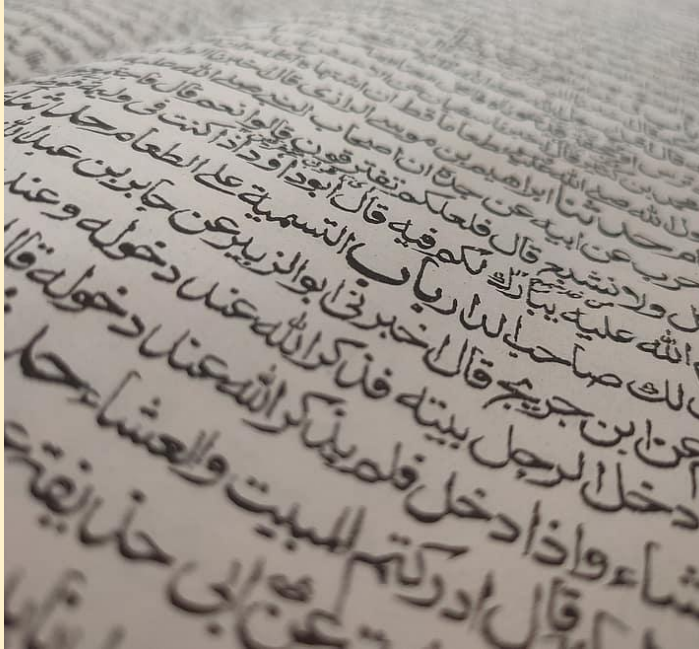

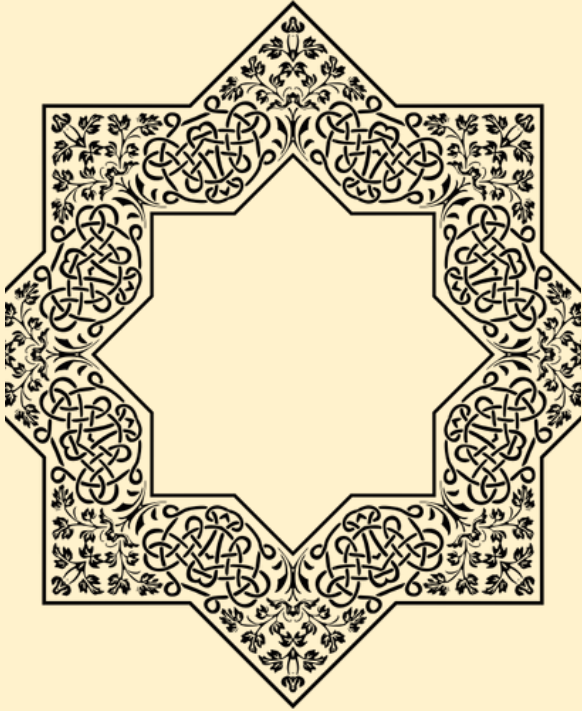
Flags & Symbols

Activity 1: Create your flag
